





Prior to termination: Medicaid must consider all program eligibility

- Federal Right: 42 C.F.R. §435.916(f)
- Lost SSI: Medicaid Communication 19-01
- Includes Medicare Savings Programs. D.C. v. DMAHS, 464 N.J. Super. 343 (App. Div. 2020)
- Review must take place before termination, with no gap in c

SSI-Related and Medicaid Only

Eligibility

- Aged: ≥ 65 years old
- Blind or Disabled (any age)

Income

- ≤\$974.25 individual; ≤\$1440.35 couple (100% SSI Benefit Rate)
- (person or couple living alone or with others in own household)

Resources

- <\$2000 for individual; <\$3000 for couples</p>
- Home and I car do not count toward resources



SSI-Related and Medicaid Only: Where do I apply?

- SSI-related Medicaid → SSI application = Medicaid application
- Medicaid Only → On-Line or with County Welfare Agencies (CWAs)

Section 1634 Disabled Adult Child (DAC)

- Eligibility Criteria:
 - At least 18 years old
 - Disabled or blind prior to 22
 - Has been receiving SSI on basis of disability
 - Has lost SSI as a result of receipt of SS benefits on parent's record due to retirement, death, or disability of the parent
 - Resources ≤ \$2000 (not including a Special Needs Trust or ABLE)
 - Financially eligible for "Medicaid Only" door in except for parental SS berial
- RFI = Request for Information

NJ Care: Aged, Blind, & Disabled

Eligibility

- Aged: ≥ 65 years old
- Blind or Disabled (any age)

Income

≤\$1255 individual, ≤\$1704 couple (100% FPL)

Resources

- <\$4000 for individual; <\$6000 for couples</p>
- Home and I car do not count toward resources



NJ Care: Aged, Blind, & Disabled Where do I apply?

New Jersey Care → On-Line or with County Welfare Agencies (CWAs) with paper application

Single Adults and parents: ACA Expansion or MAGI Medicaid

Ages: 21 - 64 year old*

No longer eligible upon turning 65

No Disability determination needed:

- OK → disability determination (e.g., SSDI)
- No longer eligible for MAGI Medicaid once <u>eligible</u> to receive Medicare

Modified Adjusted Gross Income (MAGI)

Think line #11 on the 2020 IRS Form 1040

Income ≤ \$1732/month individual; \$2351/month couple. (138% FPL)

No resource limit

NJ Workability

- Eligibility
- Age 16 and up
- Working full or part-time with proof of employment
 - Self-employed must have net earning of \$400 and file federal taxes
- Disability Determination from SSA or NJ Medical Review Team
- Total Earned Income Potential
 - Unlimited (premiums might apply at higher incomes)
- Unearned Income Threshold (e.g., alimony, SS Survivors benefits, unemployment, +)
 - Unlimited
- Resources
 - Unlimited

Managed Long Term Services and Supports (MLTSS)

Financial Eligibility

- Income ≤ \$2829* for an individual
- Resources < \$2000 for individual
- 5 year look-back: No gifting
- *Qualified Income Trust/QIT and Spousal Impoverishment protections

Clinical Eligibility

- 21 or older Hands-on assistance in 3 ADLs (e.g., bathing, dressing, ambulation) OR if cognitive impairment, supervision/cueing in 3 ADLs
- ≤20 years old More stringent skilled nursing level of care (ie: need

Financial Eligibility

- o Income ≤\$2829
- o Resources ≤\$2000
- Parental SSDI Disregarded

Clinical Eligibility

An individual must meet the functional criteria of having a developmental disability

<u>Supports + Private Duty Nursing:</u> If medically necessary; covered by Medicaid MCO alongside Supports Program

Children and Medicaid

- NJFamilyCare Medicaid: MAGI up to 147% FPL (\$3822/month family of
 4)
- ➤ NJFamilyCare Children's Health Insurance Program or CHIP: up to 355% FPL
- Waiver Programs:
 - > MLTSS with PDN for children (higher level of care than adult
 - Children's Support Services Program (SED) CSOC/Perfor
 - Children's Support Services Program (IDD) CSOC/Perform

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
